Ľudo is recognised as one of Slovakia's most accomplished private-practice lawyers in alternative dispute resolutions, being long-time “promoter” of the commercial arbitration in the Slovak Republic and frequent speaker at local arbitration conferences (for example: <https://amcham.sk/events/2832/richard-dewitt-arbitration-conference>). He is listed at the Arbitration Court of the Slovak Bar Association (<https://sud.sak.sk/en/>), being the arbitrator with the first decided case at this arbitration court after its reopening in 2016. Beside of that, Ľudo has served as an [arbitrator](#) (sole arbitrator and member of arbitration tribunal) in several international arbitrations ([VIAC arbitration](#), [ICC arbitration](#), ad hoc arbitrations). He has also served as a member of Dispute Adjudication Board in construction disputes based on FIDIC rules (yellow book, red book).

Ľudo provides legal consultancy in the field of resolving investment disputes at both a national and international level, in the area of public investments and construction disputes. He has taken part in the number of investment projects and has represented clients in international commercial disputes (ICC rules, VIAC rules, etc.), international investment disputes (under the UNCITRAL rules, ICSID rules, ECT) and before FIDIC dispute adjudication boards. He was part of the team representing the Slovak Republic in famous *Achmea case*, resulting in ECJ decision holding that arbitration clauses in BITs between EU Member States are inapplicable.
